

EURASHE Dialogue Platform of European UAS 17 March 2021, 10:00-13:00 (CET), Zoom

Objectives and background

EURASHE as a European representation of Professional Higher Education (PHE) closely follows the European policy agenda. We believe that the European Universities initiative plays a big role in the transformation of the European higher education system, will further boost reforms on inclusion, recognition, mobility and quality of teaching and learning practices. Since its beginning, EURASHE played an active role in strengthening the role of PHE in the initiative. To further support the PHE institutions within the pilot European Universities alliances and learn from their experience EURASE launched the Dialogue Platform of European Universities of Applied Sciences (UAS) with the aim to exchange experiences and views on specific PHE-related issues.

The results of the survey sent out in December 2020 showed the priority themes, the main ones are reflected in the agenda. The respondents have also stated to best benefit from an informal exchange or a workshop-type format.
