> INNOVATION & TECHNOLOGY FOR GOOD

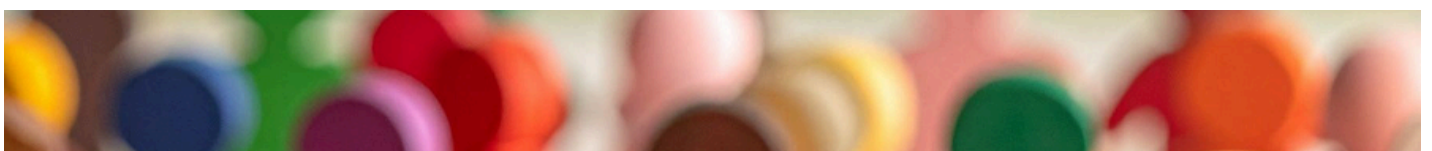
Smart systems, automation, sustainable engineering, e-marketing, digital tools for social impact, AI, emerging trends in biomedical engineering and food industry, etc.

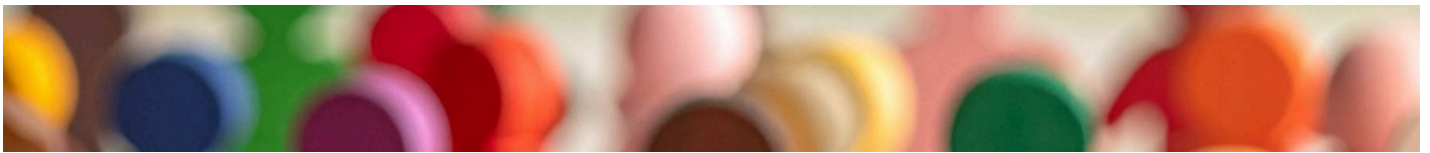
> RESPONSIBLE MANAGEMENT & ETHICAL BUSINESS
